Request made under the Official Information Act 1982

Thank you for your email of 16 November 2022 requesting the following information under the Official Information Act 1982 (the Act):

Under the Official Information Act 1982, I request data on the deaths and serious injuries that have occurred for the last five years on all of the stretches of state highways that are having their speed limits lowered by the Interim State Highway Speed Management Plan 2023-2024, with the data broken down by state highway section that is being slowed down and the cause of the accident.

For all of the deaths and serious injuries, please provide the following information:

- Location
- Time of day
- Cause of crash
- Which travel modes were involved.

Following our interim response to you on 14 December 2022, in which we released death and serious injury (DSI) information for the speed management programme segments of the Interim State Highway Speed Management Plan (ISHSMP) 2023-2024 to you, DSI information for all segments (including speed management programme segments) included in the ISHSMP 2023-2024 can be found in the following enclosed document:

Attachment 1: OIA-11942 – DSI for all segments of ISHSMP.xlsx

The data shared with you should be read in conjunction with the caveats on the first tab of the spreadsheet.

Please note, the segment details (such as location description) used to pull the DSI data provided in the enclosed spreadsheet, differ from those used to pull the data that was previously shared with you on 14 December 2022. DSI data in the two spreadsheets should not be combined – the enclosed spreadsheet includes DSI information for all segments of the ISHSMP, irrespective of segment descriptions differing between the two data sets provided to you.
