Context/ Description:

Problem:

Currently road closures on SH5/SH30/33/36 can cause long delays and frustration for general traffic and freight. If traffic can be diverted early onto another route, then savings of 30-40 mins are possible.

Outcome:

Allow traffic to make an early decision if a detour is required well before reaching the road closure. With the VMS sites being at the confluence of SH5/30, then traffic can be easily diverted, and freight doesn't need to turn around.

Propose to install two VMS board on SH5 for north/southbound traffic to inform traffic travelling on SH5 of closures on SH30 & SH5 to Rotorua or SH5/30 south of Rotorua. This is a key decision point for freight travelling from the central plateau and the port of Tauranga.

How will outcome be measured?

The amount of traffic x time saving from traffic being detoured to another route instead of travelling part way down the closed route and then having to turnaround or wait.
