Request made under the Official Information Act 1982

Thank you for your email of 29 November 2022 requesting information regarding Waka Kotahi NZ Transport Agency's Christmas parties costs under the Official Information Act 1982 (the Act). I will address each of your concern in turn as follows:

 The total budget for your department's Christmas party/parties for 2022 and 2021. Please separate costs for each year.

In creating a positive working environment at Waka Kotahi NZ Transport Agency, most of our offices have a formal social club that is tasked with organising various events throughout the year, including Christmas parties.

Every Transport Agency employee in an office with a social club is automatically a member. Membership fees are at the discretion of each social club. While the clubs are mostly free, smaller clubs might need a little extra funding to keep them going. If a member of staff does not want to be a member of the social club, they are not obliged to participate.

Generally, each Social Club is provided with \$50 per permanent staff member to spend annually, along with any remaining balance from the previous financial year. Some clubs might need to top this up with some fundraising activities. This would normally happen if the office has a smaller number of staff and it would likely cost too much to hold a function at an external venue.

There is no budget set aside for Christmas parties specifically. Usually, prior to holding a Christmas party, each social club will gauge interest from the staff in their respective office to identify the number of attendees. Subsequently, the Social Club Committee decides whether the party can be fully subsidised, or whether the attendees are required to pay for tickets. For instance, in 2022, Wellington Christmas party attendees were required to pay \$20 per person and any plus ones were required to pay \$45. Also in 2022, Auckland Christmas party attendees were not required to pay additional fees but their plus one was required to pay \$80 per person.

2. The number of parties that were or will be held in each year.

In the 2021 Calendar year, the Wellington (Chews Lane and the Majestic Centre), Auckland/ Northland, Palmerston North did not hold a Christmas Party due to the COVID-19 alert level restrictions that were in place at the time.

For the Wellington Social Club, there was a \$20 subsidy per employee to contribute towards an endof-year event which was organised by each team. The Auckland Social Club held morning teas on their offices during business hours. Meanwhile, Palmerston North Social Club organised a roast lunch at the Waka Kotahi offices (Rangitikei branch office and main Palmerston North Office).
