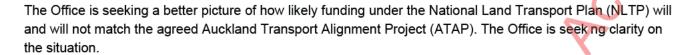
## MINO-0256 ATAP and the NLTP/NLTF

25 June 2021



The Office is particularly interested in the funding gap and whether there are alternative options for Auckland Transport not being able to provide the local share and whether anything has changed since March 2021 when Waka Kotahi NZ Transport Agency last provided advice.

## Waka Kotahi NZ Transport Agency's response:

We continue to work on the development of the 2021-24 NLTP which will recognise the Government's commitment to funding the ATAP. Our investment across Auckland in the 2021-24 NLTP will be aligned to the outcomes being sought through ATAP, and within the funding constraints of the National Land Transport Fund (NLTF).

The position since MIN-3356 (11 March 2021) has not changed. There is insufficient funding available over the next three years to do as much of the ATAP programme as desired. With the funding constraints, much of the funding needed to meet ATAP's 10-year investment expectations will be deferred until 2024 and beyond.

Waka Kotahi contribution towards delivering ATAP will ramp up years 4 to 10 and we continue to investigate options for additional financing and funding.

After meeting the requirement to fund activity classes to at least the bottom of range specified within GPS, the Waka Kotahi Board has allocated its 'discretionary' funding primarily to Public Transport and Maintenance activity classes. This prioritisation is reflected within the indicative allocations released last month. We are continuing to investigate options for additional financing and funding.

The following table provides a snapshot of indicative NLTF funding decisions in respect of ATAP for the 21-24 NLTP.

Indicative allocations for continuous programmes reflected an increase on funding from the 2018-21 NLTP but were below the amounts requested. As summarised in Table 2 below:

Waka Kotahi considers and makes funding decisions for phases of projects or programmes. Table 3 over the page sets out funding committed to ATAP project phases for the 21-24 NLTP.

The balance of ATAP projects and project phases requesting funding within the next NLTP, set out in Table 4, remain subject to assessment and moderation within the normal NLTP development process.

Waka Kotahi expects to be able to provide greater clarity of likely funding decisions in early August 2021 at the conclusion of moderation and engagement with the Waka Kotahi Board. Final funding decisions will be subject to the Waka Kotahi Board's consideration and adoption of the 21-24 NLTP at the Board Meeting scheduled for 19 August 2021.
