

Approved Full HPMV Network Route Description: South Island

Issue Date: 28 November 2023

Waka Kotahi NZ Transport Agency (Waka Kotahi) has assembled lists of state highways, bypasses and link roads that are suitable for HPMVs carrying the maximum loads available under a permit. These approved full HPMV routes cover all North Island and South Island permitting regions.

The approved full HPMV state highways, bypasses and link roads for the South Island are attached to this letter.

Holders of current HPMV permits are granted the use of these routes in accordance with the following conditions:

- This document must be used together with a current HPMV permit. The permit must have been issued by Waka Kotahi. The permit must either include a link to the web page where this document is accessible, or it must be carried together with an electronic or print copy of this document.
- Operators must comply with all conditions of the current permit, including the stated mass limits.
- Operators must comply with local bylaws and use heavy vehicle bypasses.
- Operators may use all state highways listed, including state highway off-ramps unless stated otherwise.
- No access is authorised for local authority road detours or for bridges that pass over the state highway network.

Permit holders should refer to <u>Mobile Road</u> for further details of state highway route stations (RS) and displacements.

The lists of approved full HPMV routes will be updated from time to time. Operators must use the most current revision published on the Waka Kotahi <u>website</u>.

Heavy Vehicle Bypass Routes: South Island

Key heavy vehicle bypasses are identified in the table below. The right-hand column identifies where the Road Controlling Authority has approved Waka Kotahi to permit HPMV use of the detour route.

In some instances, the Road Controlling Authority has not authorised Waka Kotahi to permit unrestricted HPMV use of the heavy vehicle bypass but allows the regional permitting team to issue permits subject to specific requirements being met. The table below identifies how these restricted heavy vehicle detours are approved.
