ADDENDUM for HPMV Higher Mass Permits

SH2 CLOSURE BETWEEN LINKS RD AND LONGLANDS RD - HPMV DETOUR ROUTE Overnight Road Closures, Mon 19th - Fri 23rd February, and Sun 25th February 2024

Due to road maintenance works on the SH2 Expressway, Hawkes Bay, there will be a road closure requiring the use of a detour route on the above dates between **8pm and 5am each night**.

SH2 will be closed in both directions between Links Road, Hastings and Omahu Road, Hastings with the traffic being detoured via local authority roads. Since the as-of-right detour route using Omahu Road is not suitable for HPMV's, HPMV's must detour via Maraekakaho Road and Pakowhai Road as shown below. The northbound detour route for HPMV's is as follows:

- Maraekakaho Road between SH2 Longlands Roundabout and the Stortford Lodge Roundabout
- and Pakowhai Road between the Stortford Lodge Roundabout and the Links Road Roundabout

And reverse for southbound traffic.



Note: These times and dates are subject to change due to inclement weather, incidents, etc with the contingency dates being Mon 26th February to Fri 1st March, although this addendum is valid for whichever days required to complete the works.

Only these approved detour routes may be used unless other LA routes are already included on your HPMV permit. In addition, the sections of Pakowhai and Maraekakaho Rds between Evenden Rd and York Rd may only be used for the duration of this project.
