## **Background:**

The enclosed document titled "Practical guidance for conducting health and safety assessments toward meeting SFAIRP obligations in the Railways Act" aims to provide voluntary guidance to rail participants in conducting health and safety assessments as part of meeting their obligations under the Railways Act (2005).

This document aligns with the priority #2 and #3 initiatives in the NRIAF workstream by establishing common principles for assessing risk and providing guidance for assessing SFAIRP and gross disproportionality.
