Motorcyclists are at greater risk of being injured on the road.

With flexible median barriers in place, you can avoid:

- being injured by a vehicle crossing the centreline
- ending up in the path of oncoming traffic if you accidentally come off your motorcycle
- hitting dangerous hazards like poles, trees and ditches.
