

Wellington State Highway 1 Urban Motorway night closures – Road closures and detour details.

Road closure and detour information:

Southbound closure

- **Sunday 11 February**
 - All southbound lanes from the Ngauranga Interchange to the Terrace Tunnel will be closed from 9 pm. to 4 am.
 - Vehicles must detour down Hutt Road, onto Aotea Quay, Cable Street, Kent Terrace, and towards the Basin Reserve to get back onto SH1.
 - Northbound traffic can travel as normal.
- **Monday, 12 February to Thursday, 15 February**
 - All southbound lanes from south of the Aotea Quay off-ramp through to the Terrace Tunnel will be closed from 9 pm to 4 am.
 - Northbound traffic can travel as normal.
 - To return to SH1, vehicles must detour down the Aotea Quay off-ramp, Cable Street, Kent Terrace, and towards the Basin Reserve.
 - An alternative detour is also available via Hutt Road.



Northbound closure

- Sunday 18 February to Thursday 29 February**
 - The Wellington Urban Motorway will be closed in parts to northbound traffic from 9 pm to 4 am each night, excluding Friday and Saturday.
 - Southbound traffic can travel as normal.
 - The northbound closure means Clifton Terrace, Tinakori Road and May Street on-ramps will close on some nights. This will affect how people within the city can enter the motorway (see on-ramp detour information below).
 - Please follow the detour signs in place and allow extra time to travel when these on-ramps are closed.
- Detour Information for on-ramp closures:**
 - Clifton Terrace on-ramp:**
 - Travel down The Terrace, right onto Bowen Street and follow signs for Aotea Quay to get onto SH1 at Aotea Quay on-ramp.
 - Tinakori Road on-ramp:**
 - Travel down Tinakori Road, left onto Bowen Street and follow signs for Aotea Quay to get onto SH1 at Aotea Quay on-ramp.
 - May Street on-ramp:**
 - Travel down Molesworth Street, left onto Tinakori Road, left onto Bowen Street and follow signs for Aotea Quay to get onto SH1 at Aotea Quay.
