# Johns Road Upgrade Sawyers Arms to Harewood

As part of NZTA's ongoing State Highway 1 improvements, City Care will be upgrading Johns Road between the Harewood Road and Sawyers Arms Road roundabouts. We will be starting on 14 January 2013 with work taking approximately 52 weeks to complete.

# WHAT WE ARE DOING:

- As part of this work, we will be widening Johns Road to four lanes. This will involve constructing new lanes, building a new central island and installing a wire barrier safety fence
- Other works include the installation of new lighting, road marking and minor underground pipe construction and improvement work
- We will be doing the work along Johns Road in two stages

1)

- Stage One will involve work in the north-western lane starting at the Harewood Road roundabout working up to the Sawyers Arms Road roundabout. We anticipate Stage one to be completed by the end of May 2013
- At Stage Two we will switch sides to the south-eastern lane commencing at the Sawyers Arms Road roundabout working back to the Harewood Road roundabout
- We anticipate all work will be completed by early February 2014.

## STAGE ONE - IMPORTANT TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT INFORMATION

#### JOHNS ROAD

- Two-way traffic along Johns Road will be maintained at all times
- During the work, please follow the traffic management signage leading up to the worksite and while travelling past the worksite. This includes keeping to the signposted speed limits
- Please follow the instructions of all onsite traffic management staff
- The cycle lane along Johns Road will remain open, however we ask all cyclists to take extra care.

#### MCLEANS ISLAND ROAD- changes to left in and left out only

- As part of NZTA's commitment to safety for all road users, traffic will no longer be able to turn right into or out of McLeans Island Road. As part of the work, safety wire barriers will be installed on the centre island to be constructed along Johns Road
- This permanent change only affects right hand turning traffic. All left-hand turning vehicles wanting to enter or exit McLeans Island Road from or onto Johns Road will be able to do so as normal
- Vehicles wanting to exit McLeans Island Road right onto Johns Road will be permanently detoured from McLeans Island Road along Logistics Drive onto Sawyers Arms Road and will need to turn right at the roundabout to get onto Johns Road.
- All vehicles wishing to turn right from Johns Road into McLeans Island Road will need to permanently detour onto Sawyers Arms Road and travel along Logistics Drive, turning right onto McLeans Island Road
- Temporary and permanent signage will be installed to direct all road users to these changes.

#### LOGISTICS ROAD USERS

- As part of the changes to McLeans Island Road traffic, Logistics Drive will experience a permanent increase in traffic
- Due to the increased traffic volumes, we ask all drivers to take extra care when exiting their properties.



- Work may also be done at night if required to minimise traffic delays at busier time. We will let local residents
  know it night work is scheduled. Please continue to follow all traffic management signage and requests during
  these hours.
