



Cambridge to Piarere expressway project

The SH1 Cambridge to Piarere expressway (a Road of National Significance) will improve safety, travel time reliability, and boost the region's economic growth.

It's a 16km long 4-lane expressway, which will run from the southern end of the Waikato Expressway, through to the SH1/SH29 roundabout at Piarere and an interchange near Karāpiro Road.

It will be designed for 110km/h speed, with median separation, side barriers, and no direct property access.

We are working on consenting, property acquisition and design and we expect construction to start in late 2026*. Construction is expected to take approximately 6-7 years.

Mid-late 2025

Geotechnical investigation and tender design progressed*

By mid-2026

First contract awarded for construction*

Late 2026

Start of construction

* Subject to a range of supporting activities, including funding, consents, permits, archaeological authorities and designations, and completing property acquisition.
