We're now in week four of the hearing into the East West Link project, which is being heard by a Board of Inquiry and held at the Ellerslie Events Centre in Auckland.

At this stage, the hearing is scheduled to run until late August, with a draft decision due on 9 October and a final decision due on 22 November 2017. More about the Board of Inquiry procedures can be found [here](#).

You're welcome to attend at any time, and a daily schedule and transcript is also available. The sessions typically run from Monday to Thursday every week.
