CONSTRUCTION CHALLENGES

Delays are inevitable during major construction works. There are several live work sites on the corridor to ensure we get the project constructed as quickly as possible. This is always balanced with the need to minimise the impact on the community.

Our traffic management plans prohibit the most invasive work, such as lane closures, from being completed during peak travel hours, unless it's unavoidable. Sometimes these are necessary to complete certain work or provide enough safe space from the traffic for our workers. Their safety is our highest priority.

We complete night works when we can. These are restricted by various factors, such as noise restrictions which are intended to ensure residents adjacent to works are treated considerately too.
