Grafton Gully Cycleway is a joint NZ Transport Agency, Auckland Council and Auckland Transport project. The new 1.9 km, 3 metre wide cycleway will run alongside the motorway at Grafton Gully.

Key Feature:

- Cost - \$11 million
- Construction Start - November 2012
- Completion - September 2014

- Supporting cycling as a healthy and safe mode of transportation.
- Providing better cycling connections throughout Auckland city.
- Helping to reduce the number of cars on the road.
