New shared path connects coastal communities

O Mahurangi-Penlink includes a separated shared path on the southern side of its road alignment between Whangaparāoa Road and East Coast Road.

Providing a great recreational opportunity for people walking or on wheels, the new path will create a scenic link between the Stanmore Bay and Stillwater communities, with a stunning view out to the Hauraki Gulf from the new Weiti River Crossing. The path will also connect its users to future residential areas along the route.

At the Whangaparāoa Road end, there will be a network of walking and cycling facilities within our project footprint, including new paths through the Cedar Reserve.

The new paths aim to provide people with a safe, sustainable and efficient travel alternative for local journeys and trips further afield.
