



Barters Road/Pound Road improvements

PROJECT UPDATE

September 2017

Project overview

This project will improve the transport links between Pound Road and SH1, and improve safety at the SH1 Barters Road intersection and rail crossings.

It is designed to cater for future growth in the area and will make it safer and easier for motorists to enter and exit Main South Road from Pound Road and improve links for cyclists and pedestrians.

A new road will be built through the Waterloo Business Park with traffic lights at key intersections, shared cycle and pedestrian lanes, and a new railway crossing. Storm and wastewater work will also be carried out over the 15-month project.

The project is expected to be complete by the end of 2017.

Work on the State Highway 1 Barters Road/Pound Road improvements started in 2016 and is now close to completion.

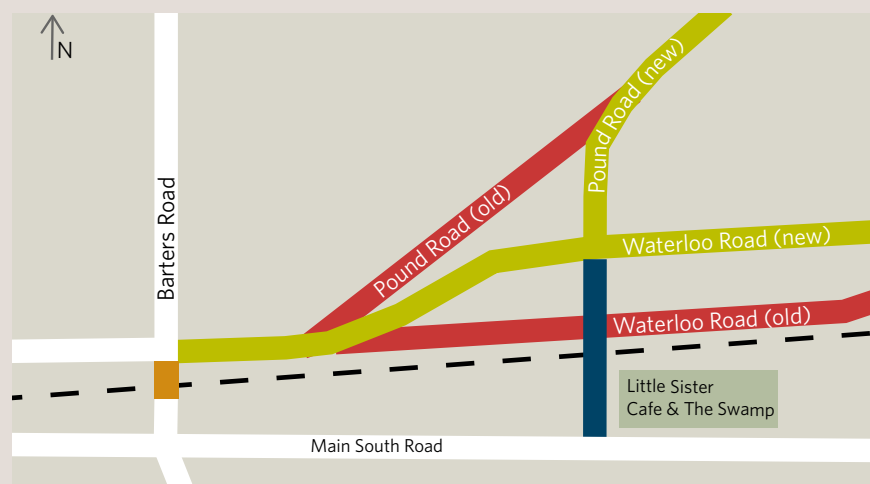
Over the past few months the project team have been working to install the traffic lights on Main South Road, Waterloo Road and Pound Road. These will be ready to be commissioned later in September.

Work on the new Pound Road railway crossing is also well underway. The signals and barrier arms are nearing completion and will be operational shortly.

UPCOMING WORK

The new section of Pound Road, between Main South Road and Waterloo Road, is due to open to traffic later this month. Before this happens, the existing Barters Road rail level crossing will need to be closed for up to 48 hours, to allow for the switching of the rail crossings on the rail network.

Please look out for signage that will indicate when this will take place. Once the new Pound Road has been opened, we can then complete the final section of road and footpaths at the Waterloo Road/Barters Road intersection along with site landscaping. Fencing will be placed along the south side of the railway tracks at Barters Road to prevent vehicles and pedestrians from crossing the tracks at this location.

SHARED PATHWAY SAFETY

Shared pathways for pedestrians and cyclists are now open on New Pound Road, New Waterloo Road and Main South Road.

Please take extra care when exiting driveways or side roads and ensure you check for both pedestrians and cyclists.

Consider trimming back plants from your driveway entrance to improve visibility for you and for people using the shared pathways.

GENERAL INFORMATION

The majority of the work will be carried out from Monday to Friday between 7:00am and 6:00pm.

Some work may occasionally be carried out on Saturdays if required.

Measures will be in place to minimise noise, dust and vibration levels.

All work is weather dependent.
