We recognise and respect Te Tiriti o Waitangi and work with Māori to build strong, meaningful and enduring relationships to achieve outcomes that benefit both parties.

We are committed to working in partnership with Mana Whenua to deliver the Papakura ki Pukekura (SH1 Papakura to Bombay) project following the principles of Te Ara Kotahi, our strategy for partnering with Māori, which recognises and provides for cultural heritage, identity and Mātauranga Māori.

Our partnership is primarily achieved through the Southern Iwi Integration Group, which is a collective iwi and NZ Transport Agency Waka Kotahi (NZTA) forum established in 2014 to discuss and consider matters of interest for Mana Whenua in relation to the development and delivery of all NZTA projects in South Auckland.

Ngā hua - outcomes and opportunities

We work in partnership with Mana Whenua to achieve social, environmental, cultural and economic outcomes. In undertaking this project we recognise 'the relationships of Mana Whenua with the land and waterways of Aotearoa New Zealand and their unbroken, living connections across the land, waterways and time'.

Our partnership with Mana Whenua has resulted in improved environmental and stormwater outcomes, including 100% stormwater treatment, and cultural outcomes including integrating cultural narratives into mahi toi (artworks) and our design, for example bridges.
