



# Waipapa corridor improvements



From the feedback we received at our Neighbourhood Evening and our Community Pop-up late March we heard that the issue causing the most concern was the loss of car parking spaces.

We undertook to continue to work with those businesses most affected to see how we might amend our design to provide more parking.

Many of the car parks on Skippers Lane and on either side of the state highway are on land owned by the NZ Transport

Agency. We are not required to provide car parking but we recognise its importance to many of the existing businesses.

We have thoroughly explored the issue of additional parking and what you can see on the plan is what we plan to provide subject to an independent safety audit.

## What happens now?

The parking we plan to provide will be the subject of an independent safety audit.

The additional layers of consultation mean that we are unlikely to be lodging our consent application until June.

We will continue to work with those landowners directly affected by the SH12 Waipapa Corridor Improvements project.

We will keep you informed as we continue to work through the construction details, traffic management plans and the programme of works.
