How could speed management on the route improve safety?

Most drivers currently travel the road at around 90km/h. A drop in speeds across SH23 from 90km/h to 80km/h would prevent over 20 deaths and serious injuries in the next decade. Combined with improvements to the road and roadside this could halve the deaths and serious injuries on SH23.



Will save over 20 deaths and serious injuries in next 10 years





What effect could speed management have on my journey?

A change in average speed from 90 km/h to 80 km/h would make the journey between Hamilton and Raglan less than three minutes longer.

A journey time of less than 3 minutes longer will save lives
