Electronic variable school zone signs

Electronic variable school zone signs are an enforceable speed limit that can be activated during peak school traffic times.

The school zone speed limit may operate from 35 minutes before school until the start of school, and from 20 minutes at the end of school, beginning no earlier than 5 minutes before the end of school.

It may also operate for 10 minutes at any other time when vehicles are entering or leaving school grounds or there is pedestrian or cycle activity on the road outside school. When the school zone is active, the speed limit is 30 or 40km/h and will be displayed on an electronic sign. At all other times, the speed limit is 50km/h.
