



# SH75 Halswell Road Improvements - Night Works

<b>What</b>	We'll be temporarily closing the road and working overnight
<b>Where</b>	SH75 Halswell Road (between Dunbars Road and Augustine Drive/Monsaraz Boulevard) and Aidanfield Drive (between Halswell Road and Bibiana Street/Euphrasie Drive)
<b>When</b>	<p>Sunday 16 November 2025, for about a week, <b>nightly</b> between 7pm and 7am (southbound) and 6pm and 7am (northbound).</p> <p>Our work is weather dependent and may need to be extended at short notice.</p>

## What are we doing?

From Sunday 16 November, we'll be installing the top and final layer of asphalt on Halswell Road and Aidanfield Drive as detailed above. We'll also be completing line marking during this time.

By paving a larger area, we can complete the work faster and more efficiently, while providing a high quality surface layer with fewer asphalt joint lines.

The work is being done at night when traffic volumes are lower to avoid congestion and disruption. It's also safer for our work crews and road users.

## Traffic impacts

The road closures will be in place **nightly** from Sunday 16 November, for about a week. The southbound lane (heading towards Halswell) will be closed **nightly** between 7pm and 7am, and the northbound lane (heading towards town) will be closed **nightly** between 6pm and 7am. Aidanfield Drive will be closed **nightly** between 6pm and 7am. This work is extremely weather dependent and may be extended at short notice. There will be no access in or out of this section of Halswell Road and Aidanfield Drive during these times - please use the signposted detour routes via Halswell Junction Road and Sparks Road.

Due to the road closures, the number 60 and number 7 bus routes will be detoured nightly. Information about the bus detours and temporary bus stops will be available at the closed stops, or online at [www.metroinfo.co.nz/timetables/updates](http://www.metroinfo.co.nz/timetables/updates). On-street parking will not be available on Euphrasie Drive 24/7 for the duration of these works due to the bus route detours. However, parking will continue to be available in the parking bays.


Our friendly staff on site can assist with any queries. Footpath access around our work site will be maintained. A temporary 30km/h speed limit will be in place where we are working so we can keep our workers and everyone safe.

*Access has been planned for and will be provided for emergency services during this time.*

## Night works and what to expect

The crews need to see what they're working on so you may notice extra lighting in the area. There will be unavoidable noise from trucks, machinery and the crews. We know that night works can be more disruptive to residents. Our team will limit any disruption as much as possible. We'll aim to carry out the noisiest work early in the shift and we'll complete the work as quickly as we can.

Once the final surfacing and line marking are done, the works on SH75 Halswell Road - between Dunbars Road and Augustine Drive/Monsaraz Boulevard - will be largely complete and the majority of temporary traffic management will be removed from site. We'll need to return at the end of the year to complete the green surfacing works, which distinguishes the bus and cycle lanes from the car lanes.
