New Zealand Transport Agency (Speed Limits on State Highways) Amendment Bylaw 2010/11

Pursuant to section 61(3) of the Government Roading Powers Act 1989, and the Land Transport Rule: Setting of Speed Limits 2003, the New Zealand Transport Agency hereby makes the following bylaw.

Bylaw

1. Title and commencement-

This bylaw may be cited as the New Zealand Transport Agency (Speed Limits on State Highways) Amendment Bylaw 2010/11 and will come into force 28 days after the date of publication of this notice in the New Zealand Gazette.

2. Amendments-

The New Zealand Transport Agency (Speed Limits on State Highways) Bylaw 2010/10* is hereby amended by:

- Amending line 890 in Schedule 1 to read:

"Line No.: 890 Region: 11 SH No.: 75 Locality: Duvauchelle Bay Section of State Highway: From 110m south of Onawe Flat Road to 130m south-east of Piper Valley Road. Speed Limit (km/h): 70 New Zealand Gazette Reference: 16/09/2010, No 120, p 3227"
