## Fleet Average - compliance plan form

The Fleet Average compliance scheme is designed to allow high volume importers to average their CO<sub>2</sub> emissions across all vehicles imported within the obligation year. This helps importers minimise their CO<sub>2</sub> charges by giving them a year to reduce the balance against other cars they've imported in the same year (or by buying credits from other importers).

### **Please note the rates per CO<sub>2</sub> grams for Fleet Average are higher than for Pay As You Go.**

Read [s 177](#) of the Land Transport Act 1998 for category 1 fees and [s 182](#) for category 2 fees.

When applying for the Fleet Average compliance scheme, you'll need to provide a compliance plan to demonstrate how you intend to manage your account to be compliant.

### **Declaration**

I declare the company has passed a resolution which confirms:

- the Entity intends to trade as the same legal entity, for at least 2 years from the date of the Fleet Average application (this is only required if your business is importing used cars).
- the compliance plan attached accurately represents the intention of the business and confirms its ability to pay any charges owing at the end of the obligation year.
