Objective of the Rule

The objective of Land Transport Rule: Work Time and Logbooks Amendment 2021 (this Rule) is to make the following amendment to Land Transport Rule: Work Time and Logbooks 2007:

• Update terminology and references to align with the *Fire and Emergency Act 2017*.

Extent of consultation

For the purposes of consultation, amendments proposed to *Land Transport Rule:* Work Time and Logbooks 2007 and other land transport rules were combined into a single draft rule, the *Land Transport Rule: Regulatory Stewardship (Omnibus)* Amendment 2020 (the Omnibus Amendment Rule). Following consultation, the provisions in the Omnibus Amendment Rule were split into separate amendment rules. The amendments to *Land Transport Rule: Work Time and Logbooks* 2007 were put into this Rule.

The NZ Transport Agency sent out notifications of the amendment proposals by email to approximately 1861 groups and individuals who had registered an interest in the rules to be amended. The Omnibus Amendment Rule was made available, together with an overview document, on the NZ Transport Agency's website. Public consultation was carried out from 25 August 2020 to 16 October 2020. The availability of the amendment proposals for comment was publicised in the *Gazette* on 26 August 2020.

The NZ Transport Agency received 23 submissions on the Omnibus Amendment Rule, none of which were regarding proposed amendments to *Land Transport Rule: Work Time and Logbooks 2007*. The submissions received were taken into account in finalising the separate amendment Rules, following which they were submitted to the Minister of Transport for signing.

1.1 Title

This Rule is Land Transport Rule: Work Time and Logbooks Amendment 2021.

1.2 Commencement

This Rule comes into force on 1 May 2021.

1.3 Principal Rule amended

This Rule amends Land Transport Rule: Work Time and Logbooks 2007.

Section 2 Amendments to principal Rule

2.1 Clause 2.2 amended (Particular situations)

- 2.1(1) In clause 2.2(4), replace "or working under the direction of a principal rural fire officer" with "or FENZ personnel".
- 2.1(2) In clause 2.2(7A), Example 2, replace "Permanent Fire Service officers" with "FENZ personnel".
- 2.1(3) In clause 2.2(8), replace "volunteer fire fighter" with "FENZ personnel who are volunteers".
- 2.1(4) In clause 2.2(8), Example, replace "A Fire Service Volunteer" with "A person who is FENZ personnel as a volunteer".

2.2 Part 2 amended (Definitions)

- 2.2(1) In Part 2, definition of **Emergency service**, replace "New Zealand Fire Service" with "Fire and Emergency New Zealand".
- 2.2(2) In Part 2, insert in the appropriate alphabetical order:

FENZ personnel has the same meaning as in the *Fire and Emergency New Zealand Act 2017*

2.2(3) In Part 2, replace the definition of **Fire brigade** with:

Fire brigade includes:

- (a) Fire and Emergency New Zealand; and
- (b) defence fire brigade as defined in the *Fire and Emergency*New Zealand Act 2017; and
- (c) an airport fire brigade; and

(d) the employed firefighters or other members of any fire brigade referred to in this definition.
